DECISION OF THE MANAGEMENT BOARD

OF 22 MARCH 2007

AMENDING THE DECISION ON LAYING DOWN RULES ON THE SECONDMENT
OF NATIONAL EXPERTS (SNE) TO THE AGENCY OF 21 SEPTEMBER 2006

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD

HAVING REGARD to its Decision on ‘Laying down rules on the secondment of National Experts (SNE) to the Agency’ of 21 September 2006 (the Decision), in particular Article 17(8), stating that the allowances paid to SNEs are reviewed each year taking into account the changes in the basic salaries of Community officials in Brussels and Luxembourg;

Whereas the adjustment of 2.3% to the salaries and pensions of Community officials and other servants of the European Communities was adopted by the Council on 19 December 2006 (OJ L 397 of 30 December 2006)

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 17 (*Subsistence allowances*), paragraphs 1, 2 and 5, of the Decision are amended as follows:

“1. An SNE shall be entitled, throughout the period of secondment, to a daily subsistence allowance. Where the distance between the deemed residence as determined in accordance with article 20 and the place of secondment is 150 km or less, the daily allowance shall be 29,44 EUR; where the distance is more than 150 km, the daily allowance shall be 117,74EUR.”

“2. If the SNE has not received removal expenses from any sources, an additional monthly allowance shall be paid as shown in the table below:

Distance between the deemed residence and the place of secondment (km)	Amount in EUR
0 – 150	0
> 150	75,68
> 300	134,54
> 500	218,65
> 800	353,2
> 1300	555,03
> 2000	664,37”



“5. SNEs who, during the three years ending six months before the secondment, have habitually resided or carried on their main occupation at a distance of 150 km or less from the place of secondment shall receive 25% of the daily allowance, which is 29.44 EUR.”

This Decision shall enter into force on 22 March 2007 and shall apply from March 2007 onwards.
