**Cabinet Order No. 71**

Riga, 23 January 2024 (minutes No. 3 34. §)

**On the Development Cooperation Policy Plan for 2024–2027**

1. To approve the Development Cooperation Policy Plan for 2024–2027 (hereinafter – Plan).

2. To determine the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as the institution responsible for the implementation of the Plan.

3. The institutions responsible and co-responsible for the implementation of the measures provided for in the Plan in 2024 should be provided with the funds allocated for that purpose. The issue of additional funding for the implementation of the measures envisaged in the Plan in 2025 and subsequent years should be considered by the Cabinet of Ministers during the preparation and consideration of the draft law on the State budget for the current year and the medium-term budgetary framework, together with the applications for priority measures submitted by all ministries and other central State institutions in accordance with the financial possibilities of the State budget. In the event that, during the process of preparation of the draft State budget law, additional State budget funding is not allocated or is only allocated partially for the implementation of the measures envisaged in the Plan, the institutions involved in the implementation of the Plan shall ensure that the measures envisaged in the Plan for which there is sufficient State budget funding are implemented.
