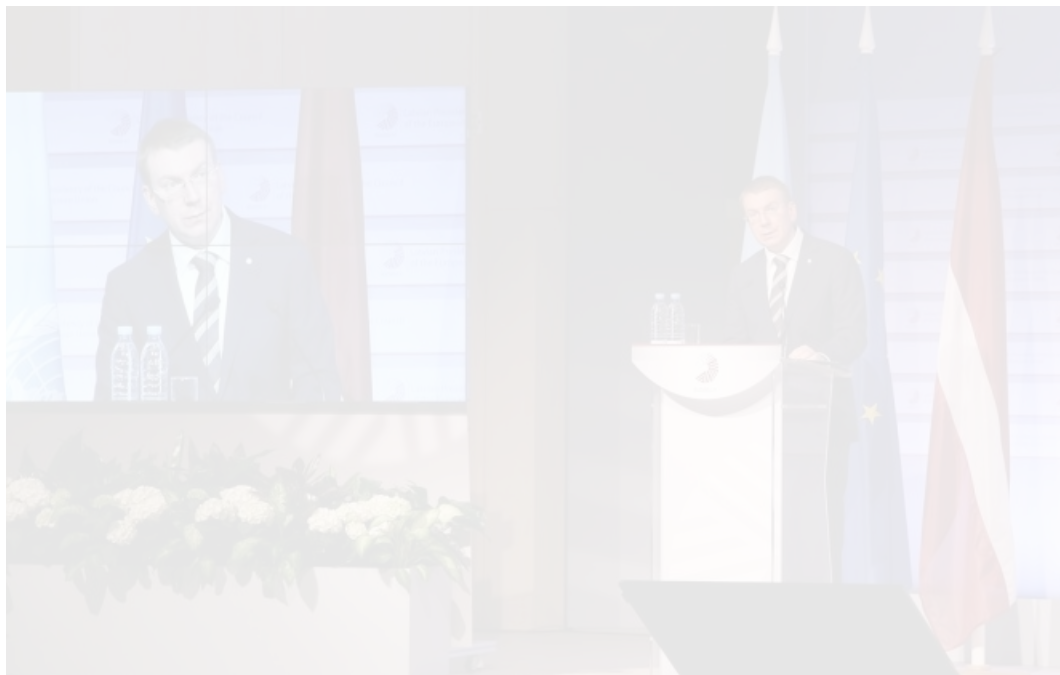


Latvia's Presidency of the Council of the EU
