

Assistance in emergency situations abroad

In emergency situations abroad the local authorities are responsible also for foreign nationals staying in the country. In order to receive urgent assistance, contact the rescue authorities: police, fire and rescue service, ambulance. In large-scale crisis follow the local media and observe the instructions provided by the local authorities.

If consular assistance is needed for Latvian nationals or unrepresented EU citizens abroad, [Latvian diplomatic/consular missions](#) should be contacted in the following emergency situations:

- loss of travel document
- detention or arrest,
- illness or accident,
- death
- criminal offence,
- relief and repatriation in a large-scale crisis,
- establishment of out-of-family care or adoption.

Latvian nationals having an emergency in a country without a Latvian mission can receive consular assistance at the diplomatic/consular mission of any other EU Member State.
